WAGE AGREEMENT 2013/2015

Attached for your attention and cascading to the membership, please find a copy of the Wage Agreement for 2013/2015 that was signed on Friday 10 May 2013 at the Transnet Bargaining Council.

Your attention is drawn to the fact that the agreement is valid for a two year period on the following basis.

- 2013/2014 ATB increase of 8,5%
- Increase to Housing allowance by 13.9% to R820p.m
- Increase to Medical Subsidy by 9,2% to R710
- Increase to Standby and Night Shift allowance by 8,5%
- Subsistence allowance increased to R70
- Overtime and Sunday increased as per Ministerial determination.
- Minimum Wage increase by 12.3% to R66041 pa
- Service Bonus paid annually on 15 December and Wages on 27 December.
- Fixed Term contractors;
 - ✓ at least 700 be fully employed (Maintenance)
 - ✓ Task team be established to set up criteria work completed by 1 October 2013.
 - ✓ Task Team: Investigation and make recommendation re:
 - increases for FTCW
 - payments to FTCW
 - increase of permanent employment
 - all related concerns
- Fixed Term Contractors; 8.5% ATB increase for those in service at signing of the agreement
- 2014/2015 ATB increase of 9 %
- Housing allowance: Increased by 12,29% to R920pa
- Medical Subsidy: Increased by 15,4% to R820 pm
- Standby and Night Shift allowance increases by 9%
- Substance allowance remains R70
- Overtime and Sunday Time increases as per Ministerial determination
- Minimum wage increases by 12.4% to R74238 pa

This agreement is with effect from 1 April 2013 - the applicable back pay will be affected on the end of May 2013.
